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## **HITRAN2008 and Current Updates**

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The current edition of the HITRAN molecular spectroscopic database<sup>1</sup> appeared in 2008. In the intervening period to the present, there have been several important updates. The archived database, as described in the HITRAN paper, is available at a public ftp site, while critical updates are posted in the HITRAN website (www.cfa.harvard.edu/hitran/updates.html). An international committee meets at least once per year and discusses the many issues involved in improving the database. These issues encompass not only acquisition of new data (both experimental and theoretical), but validation, new directions, etc.

In this presentation, we review highlight some of the successes of the current edition of HITRAN. We also discuss new directions.
