



European E-Infrastructure to Support Environmental Science

Large-scale science, such as the collaborations involving the hydrometeorology science and natural disaster community, no-longer takes place within a single country, site or research group. Having seamless access to resources (computing, storage, data, sensors, etc.) from different organisations requires a federated approach that needs to deliver a reliable integrated infrastructure.

Growing out of the experience of previous European projects, the European Grid Infrastructure has been established to federate resources from national resource infrastructure providers around Europe and around the world. The presentation will provide an overview of EGI's production infrastructure and identify the support it can provide to user communities.
