ABSTRACT

The project presented is based on the direct observation of the sun using telescopes.

Three instruments were used: a refracting telescope with h-alpha filter to observe solar prominences, a refracting telescope with a solar multimedia view eyepiece and an astronomical binoculars to observe the Sun in white light. Some pictures were made using a camera connected to the telescopes.

Granulation and prominences were visible. A few sun spots were observed.

The results of the observation and pictures have been collected in a poster built up by the students of Liceo scientifico “Carlo .Cafiero” in Barletta (Italy).
