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## Drought occurrence analysis in Tunisia

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Droughtis a terrible scourge for the Tunisianeconomybasedmainly on rainfed agricultural production. The analysis of the recurrence and the persistence of thisphenomenon by scientificmethodsseeks to establish a probabilityestimatewhichcouldcontribute to the planning of strategies for the mobilization and management of water resources. This paperaims on the analysis of the occurrence and the persistence of the meteorologicaldrought in Tunisia by Markov chain. It is on monthly data for 115 years from 24 rainfall stations distributed over the Tunisianterritory.

The studyshowedthatdroughtis a frequentphenomenonrecurringeverytwoyears or eventhreeyears or more. The probability of havingtwoconsecutive dry yearsisgreater in the western regions (the Northwest, the Center-West, and the Southwest). These regions are known for their agricultural production and their contribution. The application of the standardized precipitation index showed that the Tunisian climate is often frequented by mild to moderate weather droughts. These results contribute to the establishment of astrategy to combat drought.
