



EUREF GNSS Campaigns: the Recent Years

With the early 1990ies, EUREF turned more and more from a campaign-based reference frame realization to continuously observing stations. The EUREF Permanent Network (EPN) was established and consists nowadays of more than 330 stations.

The coordinated observation of national or small-regional networks as a means for densification of the network of stations with the goal to derive high quality ETRS89 coordinates was and is still in the focus of the European GNSS community.

This presentation gives a chronology of the GNSS campaigns of the most recent years which were presented to and validated by the EUREF Technical Working Group (TWG), and its successor, the EUREF Governing Board (GB).
