The European Research Council (ERC), Europe's premiere funding agency for frontier research, views equality of opportunities as an essential priority. The ERC monitors closely various demographic data yearly on every call and has taken actions to tackle imbalances and potential implicit and explicit biases.

The poster is focused on demographic data of the three main ERC funding schemes: Starting Grant, Consolidator Grant and Advanced Grant. The data of the ERC population is expressed statistically, with focus on gender and geographic location.

Mapping the ERC population evolution in time provides insight on the most successful host institutions/countries in the geosciences.

Recent initiatives to tackle imbalances are also presented.
