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Renewable Energies in Austria

- Presented data is based on results of a yearly tracker study which runs since 2015 and focuses on renewable energy and related topics (electric vehicles, climate change etc.)
- Nationally representative study (Gender, Age, federal state, education, income) with an average of 1.008 repondents
- Acceptance of renewable energy technologies (RET)
 - Acceptance; Acceptability; Support -> Our survey asks for endorsement of a fictional project in the community
 - Focus on small-scale hydropower plants (Hydro), photovoltaic power plants (PV) and wind turbines (Wind)




Longitudinal Trends - Hydro

SUPPORT FOR HYDRO IN COMMUNITY












Longitudinal trends – PV, Hydro, Wind

SUPPORT FOR RET IN COMMUNITY








Regional differences

Agree & Somewhat agree








Regional differences - Hydro

Agree & Somewhat agree








Regional differences - PV

PV SUPPORT - WEST/EAST








Regional differences - Wind

I would endorse a project somewhat outside my community to build a wind turbine



Predictors of Hydropower Acceptance

Model performs worse for Hydro

Gender has a stronger effect for Hydro

Typically sceptic beliefs work only, albeit weakly, for PV and Wind

Same goes for ideological convictions

Conclusion

- O Hydropower the OLD renewable energy
- O Definitely less popular compared to PV, similar to wind though?
- Experience seems to be an important aspect. Need to definitely test this.
- O Small-Scale hydropower in focus but regional differences point to little distinction in public perceptions. Same might apply to photovoltaic powerplants
- O Ideological divide does not seem to exist for Hydro as it exist for PV and Wind
- Questionable whether results really apply to actual small-scale hydropower developments
- What's to come? More in depth analyses of predictors of Hydro acceptance (climate change perceptions, social dominance orientation, actual experience ...)
