**For the Presenter:** It would be advisable if you have a short text ready that you can upload in the chat box. It will be a short introduction highlighting the main points not a full presentation. Do not just copy the entire abstract, as all session participants have had the possibility to read these prior to the chat session.

After the short introduction, the convenor will open the floor to the questions/comments.

**For the session participants:** It would be advisable if you can download the presentation materials prior to the chat session in order to have questions/comments prepared beforehand.

If no comments arrive within 1 minute, we will move to the next display. In addition, if no presenter is present for a display, we will also move on to the next display.

However, if someone have chosen not to add any further material will still have the option to discuss his/her research based on the abstract and any additional information. In this case, please rise your hand.

We have two chat time, each of 1hour and 45min. With 18 presentations in each chat time this gives **5 minute for each presentation**. Currently we do not know how many presenters will be present or how much discussion each presentation will cause. Therefore, we need to keep a tight schedule but we will still try to be flexible, if there is a lively discussion. If there will be time in the end after the full round of presentations/discussions, we can always return to discuss.

The chat session ends either when our time runs out or if the discussion ends.

**Chat will not be recorded or stored, feel free to discuss.**
