And please follow these guidelines:

- *We will discuss presentations according to the schedule which you find attached, with a 5min slot per presentation*
- *Every author has 3 minutes to briefly introduce their 3 slides (either text based or Zoom, as authors has indicated, see schedule)*
- *In Zoom the presentations will be shown by the author (via Zoom screen sharing), make sure you know how that works. Presentations should be accessible also on the EGU website.*
- *All participants in Zoom should be muted, except the presenting author and the convener*
- *The main points of the Zoom presentations will be transcribed by conveners into the text based chat*
- *We will allow for one question (if 3min presentation time is kept by authors)*
- *Questions can be asked only in the text-based chat, one question per presentation is selected by moderating convener and will be asked and answered in Zoom and transcribed to text chat by conveners.*
