



Dealing with the transport pollution in the alpine environment: the iMONITRAF! Eu Project

Alpine space is a particularly fragile environment, where relatively narrow valleys bordered by sharp relieves host peculiar atmospheric behaviours. In this fragile environment, transport pollution is one of the main pressures acting on air-quality. This work presents a summary of the indicators adopted by the iMONITRAF! project (ETS Alpine Space) to assess and quantify this pressure, monitoring its trend in the different years, modulated by the different atmospheric determinants in the main transport corridors of the Alpine Space. Preliminary results of this monitoring system will be presented as well.
