



Weather forecasting services at the National Observatory of Athens: available products and ways of presentation to the public through www.meteo.gr

The www.meteo.gr has been launched in 2002. It is a site that provides weather forecasts and current weather conditions over Greece. The content includes: general forecasts over Greece in text format, weather related news, audio weather forecasts, weather forecasts over more than 400 Greek cities and locations, interactive weather forecast maps over the maritime areas (wind and waves), UV index forecasts, forecasts of European Capitals, forecasts and detailed information for the Greek ski centres, forecasts and swimming conditions for the Greek beaches, dust forecasts, current weather conditions at ~340 locations over Greece based on the network of automated weather stations operated/supervised by the National Observatory of Athens, lightning occurrence maps, web-cameras over Greece, educational material.

After 15 years of operation the www.meteo.gr is the most visited site of the public domain in Greece and the among the top5 Greek sites in terms of average daily unique visitors.
