



Towards Enhanced Resilience: U.S. National Space Weather Strategy and Action Plan, and Associated Policy

In 2015, the United States released the National Space Weather Strategy and Action Plan, which defines goals and activities, to include enhancing international engagement. These documents seek to augment preparedness for space weather events by coordinating and prioritizing activities of U.S. executive departments and agencies. This talk will review the formulation of these policies; and discuss how implementation has enhanced research activities, operations, national preparedness, public awareness, and international engagement.
